### **COUNTY OFFICIALS WARN AGAINST PROPERTY TAX SCAM**

#### **"Distraint Warrant" Scam**

**LOS ANGELES, CA** - Los Angeles County Treasurer and Tax Collector, Keith Knox, is alerting the public to an alleged property tax scam, whereby taxpayers are notified of Distraint Warrants as a means to collect unpaid taxes.

The Los Angeles County Treasurer and Tax Collector does not issue Distraint Warrants. If you receive a letter like this one: [click here](#) and it appears to be sent from the Los Angeles County Treasurer and Tax Collector, **it is a scam! Do not fall victim to it.**

Constituents who receive this type of notification should report it to their local law enforcement agency.
